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

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

Interesting Facts About South America

ANGEL FALLS

a. Angel Falls is the tallest uninterrupted waterfall in the world:

With a height of 979 metres (3,211 ft) and a drop at 807 metres (2,648 ft), this is the highest or tallest uninterrupted waterfall in the world.

b. It gets its name from an American, adventurer:

Angels Falls is Salto Angel in Spanish. The Falls got their name from American adventurer, James Angel. James was the first outsider to see the falls. He flew over them in 1933. He then returned to The Falls in 1937 with the intention of landing his plane.

c. It is the 'waterfall of the deepest place': The indigenous and official name is Kerepakupai merú which means 'waterfall of the deepest place'.

d. Angel Falls are part of the Orinoco River system:

Angel Falls are a tributary of the Carrao River, which is itself a part of Venezuela's Orinoco River system. At 2,250 kilometres (1,400 miles), the Orinoco River is one of the longest rivers in South America.

e. The best time to visit the Angel Falls:

The best time to visit the Angel falls is during rainy season which is June to December .

AMAZON RIVER

a. The Amazon River Once Flowed in the Opposite Direction: Between 65 and 145 million years ago, the Amazon River flowed towards the Pacific Ocean, in the opposite direction how it flows today.

e. It Has Over 100 Dams:







The Harappan Civilization

In the nineteenth century, archaeologists discovered two cities, Harrapan and Mohenjo Daro which were buried underground.


There were many different opinions about the name of the Harappan Civilization. In the beginning of research, the archaeologists found many artifacts near the river Indus. So, they gave name to this river as "Indus Valley Civilization". But soon they found that Harappan Civilization was spread over the large areas of Pakistan, Baluchistan, India-Haryana, Northside of Rajasthan and Gujarat. Harappan Civilization was around 7,00,000 km. This civilization was divided into two parts: - Village Area and City Area. In the village area the main occupation was farming. They grew wheat, mustard, peas and cotton. But in the city, people were engaged in trading many places and they were very skilled. A big granary was there in the city of Harappa and Mohenjo Daro, which proved that the people kept food for future.

The buildings of Harappans were made of clay bricks. The archaeologists found two types of houses. Some people lived in the clay bricks houses which were baked in the ovens. Some houses were double-storeyed which proves some people were rich and some were poor. There were 27 wells which carried water into the houses. The dirty water could flow from the bathroom into a drain that carried into a large drain. Some seals were found which looked like unicorn-one horned animal. They were very religious people. But suddenly this civilization disappeared. Many scholars believe that the collapse of this civilization was due to an earthquake or due to the change in climate.




The Foolish Servant


