
Navy flag from 1947



The octagonal shape represents the eight direction reach and multi-direction operational capability, the octagonal shape with border, golden draws broad inspiration from the seal of the great Indian Emperor Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.

PARAM VIR CHAKRA

Param Vir Chakra is India's highest military decoration.

It is awarded for the most outstanding bravery or some daring or top ranking act of bravery or self-sacrifice in the presence of the enemy, whether on land, at sea or in the air. The Param Vir Chakra is a very rare honour . so far, it has been awarded only 21 times .

Fourteen of these awards were dead after a person's death



The medal itself is very simple in appearance .It is made of bronze, and is fitted with survival mounting and has a plain purple ribbon. On the obverse it has the Indian national emblem at the center, surrounding by on the reverse, the words Param Vir Chakra are engraved in Hindi and English, with two lotus flowers in between. The Param Vir Chakra medal was designed by Savitribai Khanolkar. She was an European lady, who married Vikram Khanolkar, an Indian Army officer.




After the enlightening session we all were served with Frooty and Biscuits.






As we use refrigerator to keep our food preserved, then in earlier times which device kept food preserved? In order to keep food cool, ancient people stored them in ice pits. This was done 4000 years before.

Insulated cabinets for keeping ice or in other words, domestic refrigerator first came to existence around 1850 in the United states. In 1879, a German engineer 'Karl Von Linda' developed first mechanical refrigerator which was powered by a steam pump.



Within 12 years about 12,000 refrigerator were sold in United states and Germany. Two Swedish engineers, 'Von Platen' and 'Munters' developed the first electric refrigerator which went on scale in 1925. The main principle that on which it worked was compression and absorption. Compression and absorption system cools by alerting a refrigerator from a liquid state to gaseous state and back into liquid form. The refrigerator has a storage tank filled with 'Freon' gas, the refrigerant control device, the evaporator, compressor and condenser.


समाजाची मदत करून सर्वांचे प्राण वाचवायचे आहे.






OZONE (0-3)

Ozone or trioxygen is an organic molecule with the chemical formula O3. It is a pale blue gas with a distinctively pungent smell.

Ozone is formed from dioxygen by the action of UV rays and electrical discharges within the Earth's atmosphere. It is present in very low concentrations through out the latter, with its highest concentration high in the ozone layer of the stratosphere, which absorb most of the Sun's Ultra Violet radiation.

Ozone layer is a layer of molecules of Ozone present around the Earth. The



layer acts like a blanket and protects the Earth from harmful UV rays emitted from the sun. Without Ozone layer the harmful UV rays will directly come to the surface of the Earth. UVrays can damage our planet, plants, humans and animals. Ozone layer is very important for life and natural balance on the Earth. Now a days several holes have been found in it which is not a good sign.

This is due to environmental degradation and rise in temperature. Planting trees, using eco-friendly goods can help to save the Ozone layer. We should spread awareness about protecting the Ozone layer. Ozone is considered as a pollutant also. Ground-level Ozone comes from pollution emitted from cars, powerplants industrial boilers, refineries and chemical plants. ACID BASE REACTION
